

Problem: up to date information on assets

- Solution:
 - ARO request prior to EFO/ECO
 - quick way for balance check bank accounts –
 f.i. via ARO







Problem: Time needed for drafting, sending, executing freezing orders vs urgent requests

- Solution:
 - EFO in English for urgent requests
 - Central authority for urgent requests
 - Urgent freezing/interim measure prior to EFO
 - Soft freeze crypto currency via direct contact exchanges prior to EFO





Problem: Use potential of EFO to full extend – art. 7(1) REG – financial investigations

Solution:

align national law in MS with art. 7(1) REG
 competent authority for EFO also competent to perform financial investigations to (1) investigate whereabouts of assets; (2) trace other assets of suspects in MS





Problem: Quality of certificates / use of correct certificate

Solution:

EFO adjustments to part D of certificate:
(1) freezing needed for object/value confiscation
(2) request for financial investigations
Education of practitioners in MS

- Guide/handbook for drafting certificate





Problem: Restition of money to victim in case of frozen bank accounts

Solution:

- EU harmonised rules for banks and law enforcement how to deal with requests for freezing and restitution of transferred funds in case of fraud, swindling, cybercrime, etc.







Problem: Freezing of assets for victim compensation/restitution

Solution:

- Extend scope of freezing order under REG (will make execution of victim compensation measures under FD 2005/214/JHA easier)







Problem: Improve (understanding of) communication between competent authorities Solution: - Use of standard forms for f.i.: (1) confirmation of receipt, including contact details of executing authority (2) recognition/refusal (3) result of execution EFO: assets frozen, estimated value

- Contact between authorities before sending EFO





Problem: Securing assets in execution phase (ECO)

Solution:

 Possibility of sending EFO when ECO is irrevocable

 Art. 18 (5) REG: freezing assets without EFO prior to recognition ECO (and perhaps include section in certificate ECO to request for freezing/securing assets prior to recognition ECO)
